



## ROME, TUSCANY & THE CINQUE TERRE • JUNE 26-JULY 7, 2012

### TUESDAY, JUNE 26

Depart the USA for Rome, Italy.

### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 27 (ROME)

After our arrival in Rome, transfer to our charming hotel by motor coach. Explore Rome's famous Trastevere neighborhood and enjoy a welcome dinner at a local trattoria. (D)

### THURSDAY, JUNE 28 (ROME)

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at our hotel. Take a guided tour of Rome's famed sights: the Coliseum and Roman Forum; St. Peter's Basilica, the Vatican museum and the Catacombs. Later, revel in the energizing nightlife of Rome. (B)

### FRIDAY, JUNE 29 (ROME)

Shop or explore Rome on your own, then cap the day with a dinner at a quaint restaurant in the Trastevere neighborhood. (B)

### SATURDAY, JUNE 30 (CINQUE TERRE)

Following breakfast, we'll drive along the Ligurian coast to the Cinque Terre. Get acquainted with the eclectic collection of Cinque Terre villages and the walking paths that connect them. Spend the remainder of the day hiking the scenic paths, enjoying the dramatic views from a boat, or simply relaxing at a local beach. (B)

### SUNDAY, JULY 1 (CINQUE TERRE)

Take the full day to venture out and discover the charms of these adjoining villages. The day is yours to visit and explore the seaside, sample the local cuisine and wine, and enjoy the spectacular sunset. (B)

### MONDAY, JULY 2 (CINQUE TERRE)

Spend your final day on the Ligurian Coast relaxing at the seaside, taking a boat trip or traveling to a neighboring village. (B)

### TUESDAY, JULY 3 (TUSCANY)

After breakfast, drive to our hotel located in the Tuscan countryside stopping for lunch and a visit in a quaint Tuscan hilltown. Sample local regional wines and later

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT:** Prices are based on double occupancy. A deposit of \$600 per person is required to reserve space (due FEBRUARY 1, 2012). Balance is due MARCH 1, 2012. Payment must be made by check.

**BAGGAGE:** Due to limited motorcoach capacity on the land portion of the tour, transportation and portage of one suitcase per person will be accepted. The organizers of the tour accept no liability for loss or damage to luggage, although maximum care will be taken to insure safe handling of your luggage.

**CANCELLATIONS:** All cancellations must be received in writing. For cancellations received on or before MARCH 1, 2012, a fee of \$300 per person will be charged. For cancellations received between MARCH 2 and APRIL 1, 2012, a cancellation fee of \$600 per person will be charged. There is NO REFUND for cancellations received on or after APRIL 2, 2012. **Most trip insurance companies cover cancellation. Please check your coverage plan for details.**

**INSURANCE:** Personal trip cancellation, travel accident and baggage insurance is strongly recommended.
